Theme: Jobs people have and the clothes they wear



**Brainstorm and Discuss** 5-15 minutes Ages 3 and Up

# Discuss the following questions:

- What are some jobs people have that you can see from your window?
- What do they wear that helps them to do their job better?
- Do you think they wear their clothes to stay safe? Do they wear that so other people know who they are?
- What are some jobs people in your home have?
- If you could have any job, what job would you choose? Why? And what would you have to wear to do your job better?

# **Jobs in Our Neighborhood Charades**

Practice finding imaginative ways to show different jobs in your neighborhood through costume in a game of charades! There are many different kinds of jobs we see in our neighborhood. Use some of the ideas you brainstormed in the A Think! section to create in your game. See what costume pieces you can find to portray these jobs from what you have in your house!



Create & Act 15-25 minutes Ages 3 and Up

Step One: Read over the list of jobs below:

- · A Mailperson
- A Delivery Person
- · A Visiting Nurse
- · A Garbage Person/ Sanitation Worker
- · A Bus Driver
- · A Teacher (Maybe they are teaching virtually)

Add any other jobs you can think of. You can even add some jobs you would like to have one day! Maybe an artist, an athlete, a zookeeper, or even even a pirate or a wizard! Think Outside the Box! Be silly!

Step Two: Head to your closet (or your costume box, if you have one) and pluck out some items that might work for some of these jobs.

Step Three: Quick change time! Have someone in your family shout out these jobs at random. You have one minute to quickly change into the outfit that best represents this character! When the minute is up, hit a pose that really brings that job to life!



### **Outside the Home Scavenger Hunt**

This is a fun activity to do on a walk outside, or on the way to school, or running errands. On this scavenger hunt we want to see what observations you can make about what people are wearing to their jobs?
